


Intravenous Paracetamol Guideline

Does patient meet following criteria for intravenous paracetamol?

In acute pain and one or more of the following applies:

- Acute vomiting
- High nasogastric aspirates
- Mucositis
- Inadequate gut for effective enteral absorption
- Unsafe swallow with no enteral tube access
- Following one of the approved ERAS (enhanced recovery after surgery)
 pathways that includes the use of i.v. paracetamol post-operatively
- Acute Pain Service has advised the use of i.v. paracetamol



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
