*SEVERE PENICILLIN ALLERGY

Type 1 | Acute

Anaphylaxis
Angioedema
Urticular rash/pruritus
Hypotension and/or bronchospasm and/or stridor
Asthma exacerbation/wheezing

Type 4 | Delayed

Severe cutaneous adverse reactions with systemic involvement (e.g rash associated with blisters, skin peeling, mucosal inflammation, purpura).

**NON-SEVERE PENICILLIN ALLERGY

Maculopapular/morbilliform rash including widespread red macules or papules (exanthema-like) or fixed drug eruption (localised inflamed skin)

Serum sickness like reaction (fever, rash, arthralgia)
Glomerulonephritis

NB: Symptoms such as minor GI symptoms, minor headache or benign rash or minor rash occurring after 72 hours should be classified as an intolerance rather than allergy.

CONTRA-INDICATED

Avoid in severe*
and non-severe**
