
Treatment Guideline



TREATMENT OF VITAMIN D DEFICIENCY - RAPID LOADING

Only to be used for **hospital in-patients** where rapid correction of Vitamin D deficiency is necessary in order to give potent parenteral osteoporosis therapies (i.e. Zoledronic acid or Denosumab).
