Toilets

All of the toilets marked on this map are accessible and wheelchair friendly with the exception of the toilets by Fosters Cafe (please see marked on map).

If you need a larger space to change someone in your care, please navigate to the Changing Places toilet, located by our Pharmacy in the Main Block.



Changing Places

This is accessible with a Radar key and if you do not have yours to hand, you can call our Portering Services who hold a spare key. Information is on the front of the door.

Prayer Room

The prayer rooms are opposite Fosters restaurant and contain resources for many world faiths. Muslim prayers are held in the Prayer Rooms every Friday at 1.30pm, but they are available at other times for anyone who requires a private, quiet place for reflection or meditation.

Fosters Cafe opening times:

Monday - Friday: 7.30am - 6.30pm Saturday - Sunday: 8am - 2.30pm

Costa Coffee opening times:

Monday - Friday: 7am - 7pm Saturday: 10am - 6pm Sunday: 11am - 6pm Out of hours there are vending machines located next to Fosters restaurant.



Shops

Amigos opening times:

Monday and Tuesday: 7am - 6pm Wednesday, Thursday, Friday: 7am - 7pm Saturday and Sunday: Closed



Cash point

There are two cash points.

One in the Atrium and one within the Amegio shop which is only available during its opening hours.



The chapel is on the Ground Floor of the Tower Block. Here you will find a 'prayer tree' and a prayer book where you can request prayers.

If you need any additional support navigating around the hospital site do speak to one of our hospital staff who will be wearing a **yellow name badge** or a **hospital lanyard.**




Welcome
