## 1. Need for Improvement


Women who sustained a significant perineal trauma through childbirth were seen in the postnatal period by a consultant Obstetrician. This was booked in one of the busy ante natal clinics resulting in long wait times for the women and their new born babies. The women then had to attend a separate appointment with the physiotherapists.

#### 2. Aim


To reduce the DNA rates and unnecessary additional clinic attendances for women by 50% by July 2018

# 4. Measurement


- DNA rates
