

ClinicalKey is a search engine that holds:

- 1000 e-books
- 600 e-journal Elsevier titles including The Lancet.
- 2000 Drug monographs
- & over 2 million images!

It is important to note that drug information should be checked with Medicines Information as it is Americanised on ClinicalKey.

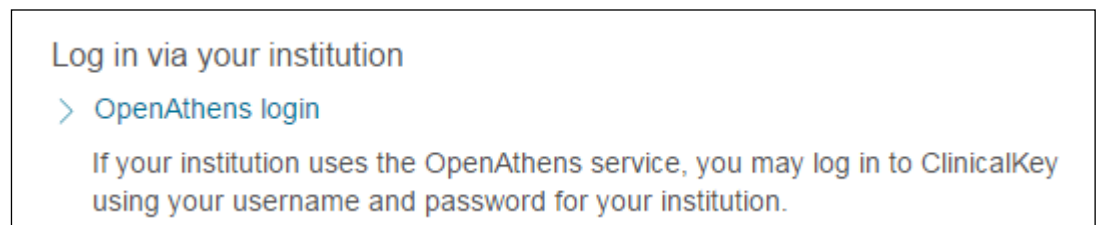
Getting Started

1. Select Login from the top right hand panel:

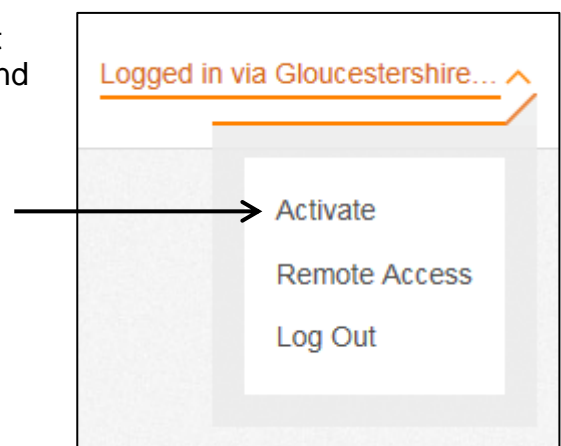


2. Ignore the username and password box, instead choose OpenAthens:

If you do not have Athens access register via the library website



3. Set up a personal account by clicking the top right hand corner **Logged in via Gloucestershire...** and select Activate.



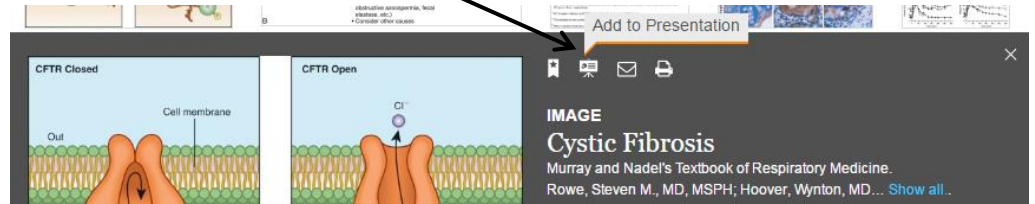
You can now run searches via the main page, browse specific topics/journals/books, watch videos, view images and save all of these to your profile.

Presentations

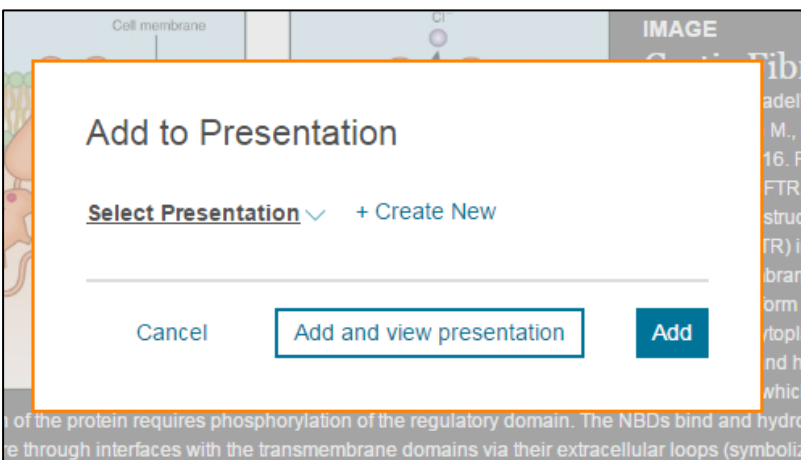
When you save images you can also create a presentation which will export to PowerPoint.

Example of adding an image to a presentation:

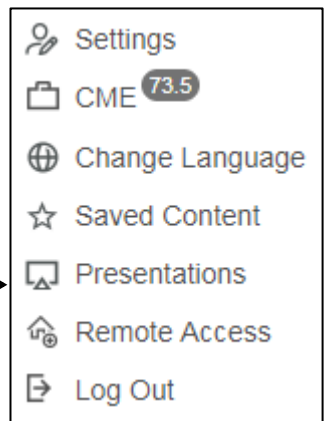
Select the image you want to add and click slideshow icon:



Create a new presentation, or add the image to one previously made:



To view your presentation click on your name in the top right corner of the page, select presentations.



Then export to PowerPoint, along with full reference and copyright information by clicking 'export' on the right of the screen:
