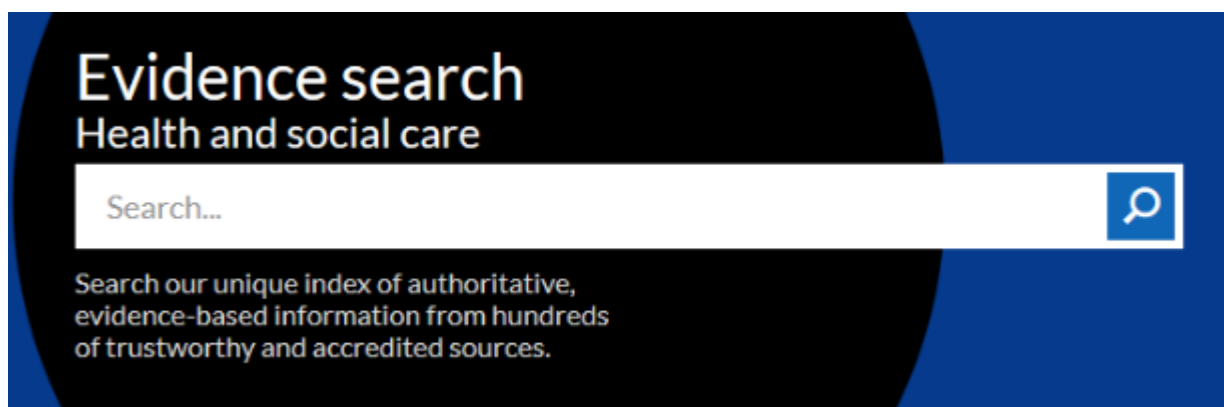

This is a 'one box does all', put in your key terms and use the filters that appear afterward to narrow your search – essentially it is a search engine with results you can be confident are trustworthy.

Search tips

Phrases

To search for a phrase, place quotation marks around the terms e.g. *“Diabetic Foot”*

Variations of words

To search for all variations of a keyword, enter the first few letters of the word then type a *
e.g. *midwi** = midwifery, midwife, midwives

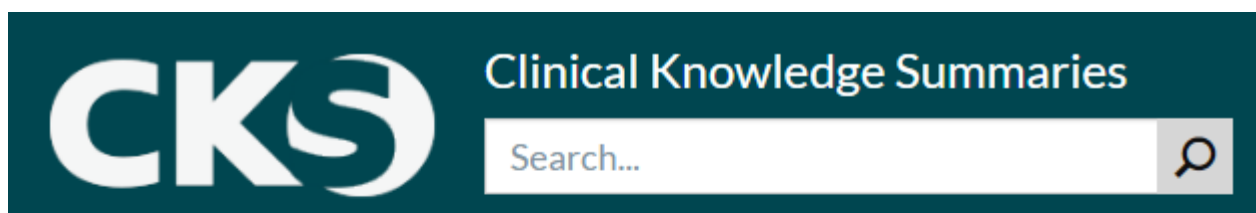
Use AND/OR/NOT

- Type *Children AND Asthma* to retrieve results with both terms
- Type *hayfever OR “allergic rhinitis”*, and results will be retrieved which include either phrase
- Type *paediatric NOT children* and results with the word ‘children’ will not be retrieved
