Sample Requirements : Standard Coagulation Tubes.

Either as: 2 citrated blood samples despatched to arrive in the laboratory within 48 hours of sample collection as un-centrifuged whole blood (stored at room temperature)

OR: Double spun plasma (at 2,000g) divided into 4 aliquots (minimum volume 150 µL in each).

Freeze immediately at -70°C. Send frozen / on dry ice to: **Haemostasis Laboratory, Level 8 Queens Building, Bristol Royal Infirmary, Upper Marlborough Street, Bristol, BS2 8HW.**

Samples must be in the lab by 12 noon if urgent and require testing on the same day.

We normally test one batch per week depending on Clinical need. Monday-Friday 9am-5pm, with the exception of Public and Bank holidays. Please send a completed copy of this form with your request form.

If ADAMTS13 activity is normal and you suspect aHUS contact
