## Spotlight on... Baseline and Ongoing Data

Data is a vital element of any QI project, from understanding that an improvement opportunity exists, to regular data collection throughout the project to evidence improvement. Once the improvement level is sustained, the project can move away from the 'active' improvement phase and into ongoing assurance.

Both Quantitative (numerical) and Qualitative (wordy) data provide valuable insight into improvement work. Consider a patient or staff story to highlight the improvement need and create a tension for change. Data, evidence and experience support is available within the Trust from TeamGSQIA as well as:
