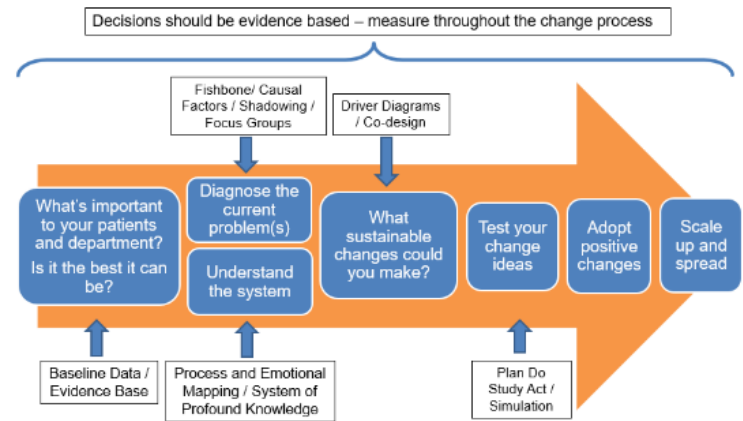


Silver Edition - Hands up, who's not done their Silver course (yet!)? The Silver course provides project teams with support to complete their own structured QI project. If you're experiencing a problem that doesn't have an obvious solution, then consider using QI to test, learn and improve. **When will you do yours?**



Before signing up...

- Have you completed your Bronze course? We ask that everyone undertakes the Bronze level QI introduction to provide a good grounding in QI tools and techniques
- Collect and review baseline data – this is the data that shows there is a problem that needs fixing. It will form the basis of your ongoing data collection, support your measures and help create your SMART Aim
- Find a buddy and sign up – we suggest that where possible, you tackle your Silver project in pairs or small groups rather than as an individual

Already completed a Silver project? consider:

Gold – Quality Improvement Coach – Additional training modules and reflective practice to become a QI coach

Human Factors - Introduction to Human Factors - Half day workshop and Human Factors in Practice - One and a half days workshop for those keen to gain further knowledge, practical skills and approaches to improve performance and reduce errors

Patient Safety Associate Programme – Practical knowledge and skills in all aspects of patient safety – human factors, safe systems, risk management, incident management and creating a just culture – 7-month programme, one study day per month
