



Colonoscopic Surveillance in Inflammatory Bowel Disease

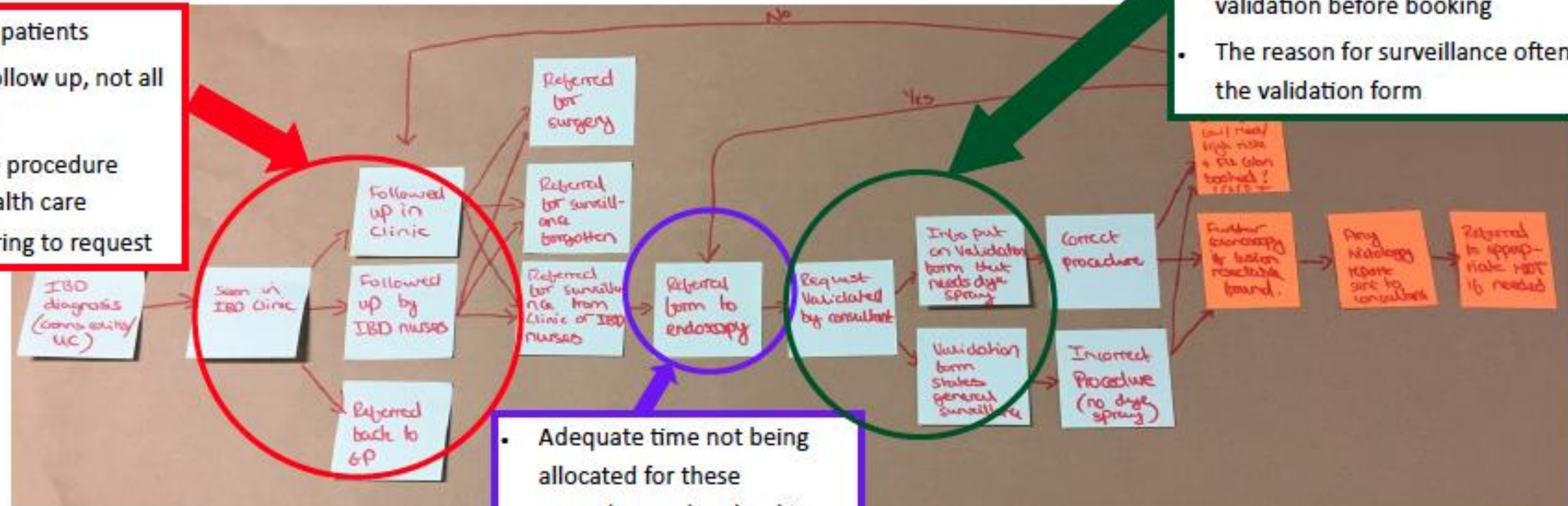
Improving the service for our patients

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Aim: 30% of eligible IBD patients are offered a surveillance colonoscopy that meets the NICE guidelines in the next 6 months

Plan : Process mapping our current practice

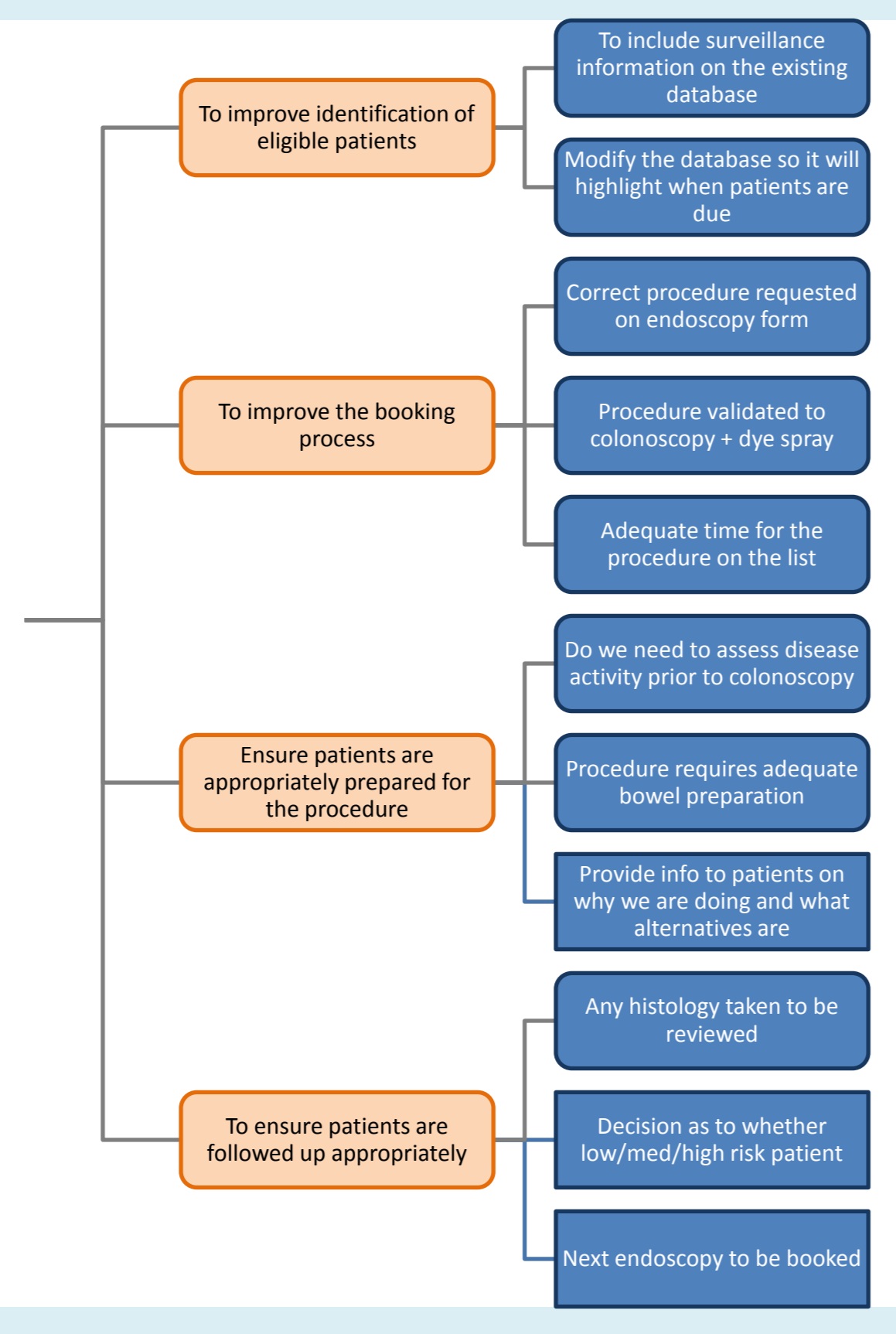
- No central database of patients
- Different methods of follow up, not all seen regularly in clinic
- Request of surveillance procedure relies on reviewing health care professional remembering to request



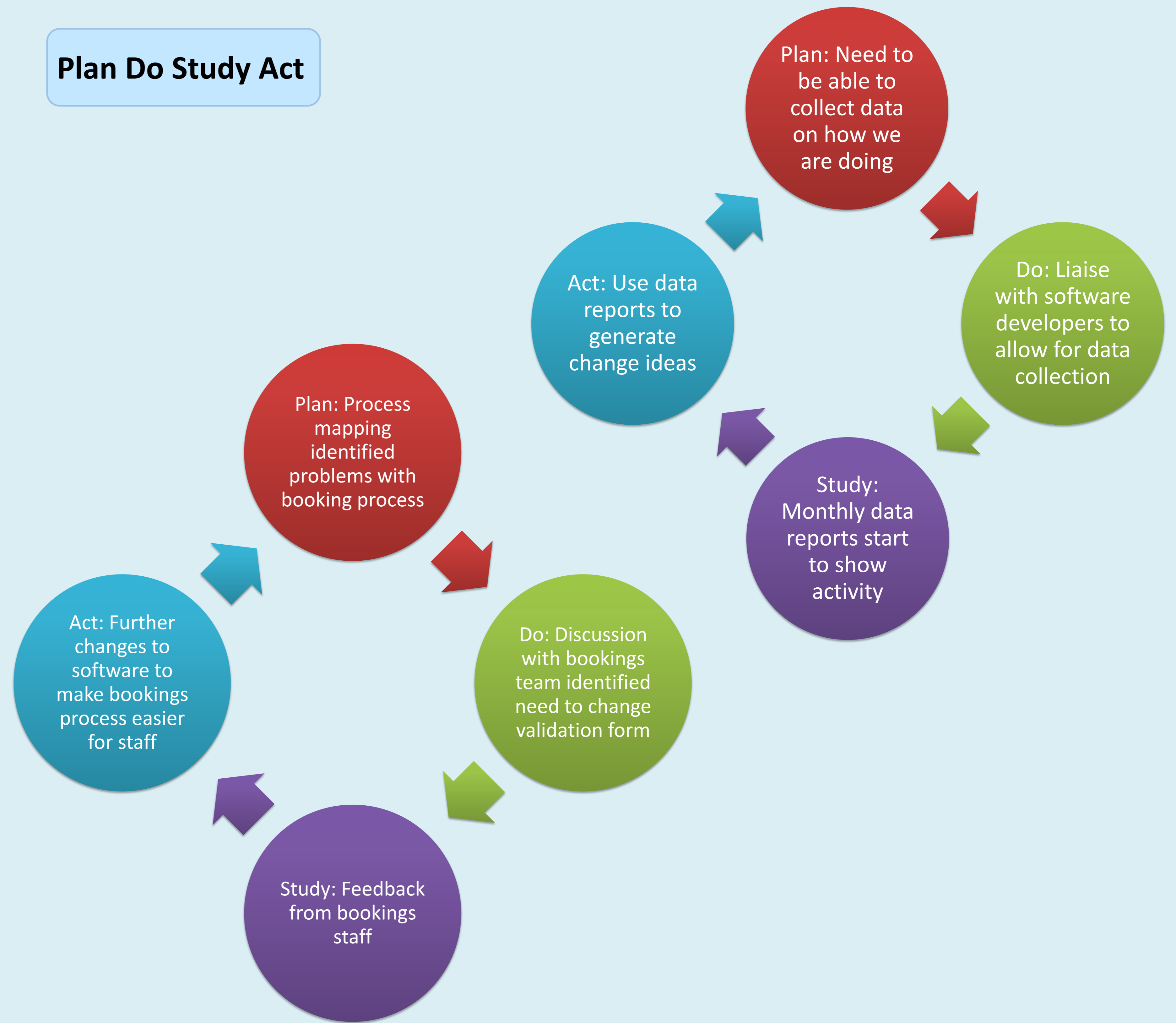
- Adequate time not being allocated for these procedures when booking

Driver Diagram

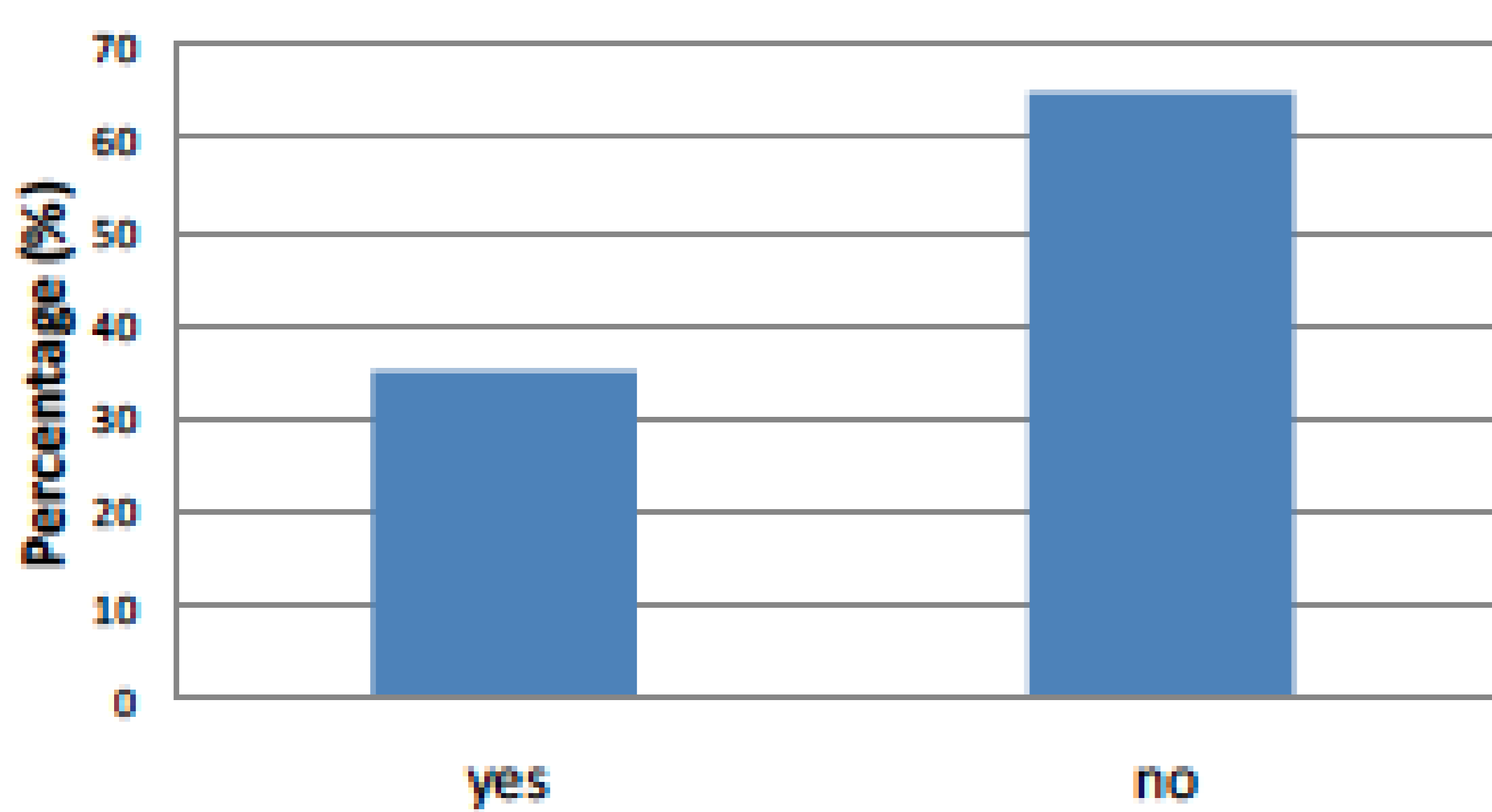
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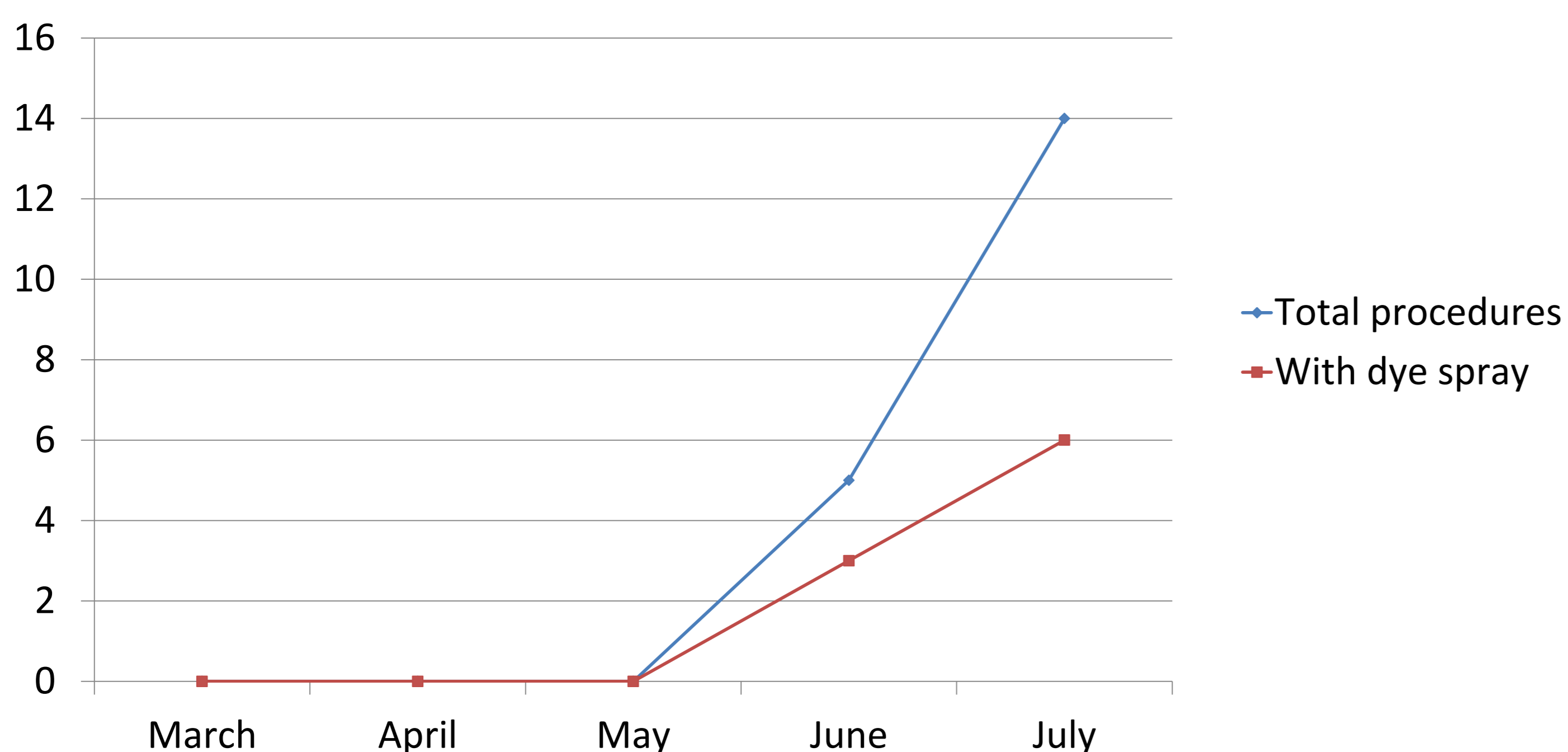
